Part 4: The Battle Plan - Rev 6-22

I. THE BATTLE PLAN – CHRONOLOGICAL SECTION #2

- A. 7th Seal: Revelation 8:1-5
 - 1. 7 Angels with 7 Trumpets
 - 2. Prayers of the church: Revelation 8:1-5
 - a. Silence in heaven – half hour
 - (1) Let all the earth be silent – Hab 2:20
 - b. Angel
 - (1) Much incense – Heb 7:25
 - (2) Prayers of the saints – Ps 141:2
 - (3) Offered upon the altar
 - c. Golden censer – Lev 16:12; Num 16
 - (1) Filled with fire from the altar
 - (2) Threw it to the earth
 - d. Result – our prayers release the 7 trumpets
 - (1) Peals of thunder
 - (2) Sounds/voices/rumblings
 - (3) Lightning
 - (4) Earthquake #2
- B. 7 Trumpet Judgments: Revelation 8:6-9:21
 - 1. In response to the prayers of the Church
 - 2. Trumpet judgments
 - 3. Trumpets 1-4: Weakening the resources of the antichrist kingdom
 - a. Trumpet #1 – 1/3 of trees burned up: 8:6-7
 - b. Trumpet #2 – 1/3 of sea turned to blood: 8:8-9
 - c. Trumpet #3 – 1/3 of fresh water turned bitter: 8:10-11
 - d. Trumpet #4 – 1/3 of celestial light darkened: 8:12

4. 3 Woes declared
 - a. Trumpet #5 - Demonic torture: Rev 9:1-12
 - b. Trumpet #6 - Demonic slaughter of 1/3 of mankind: Rev 9:13-21
 - c. Trumpet #7 –Bowls of wrath released
5. Trumpet #5
 - a. A star from heaven which descended to the earth
 - (1) Given the key to the bottomless pit – Rev 1:18
 - (2) Smoke of a great furnace darkens the air and sun
 - b. Demonic locust
 - (1) Power of the scorpion given to them
 - (2) Do not hurt the grass, trees, etc
 - (3) Only the men who are do NOT have the seal of God
 - (4) Not permitted to kill anyone for 5 months
 - (5) Death unachievable
 - c. King is named ‘destroyer’
6. Trumpet #6
 - a. 4 angels bound in the Euphrates
 - (1) Prepared for this day to kill 1/3 of mankind
 - (2) Lead an army of 200 million
 - b. Mounted demonic army
 - (1) Breastplates of fire, hyacinth, brimstone
 - (2) Power in the horses – fire, smoke, brimstone
 - (a) From the mouth
 - (b) From the tails
7. The rest of mankind who survived still refuse to repent
 - a. Continue worshipping the very demons who killed them
 - b. Neither did they repent of their murders, sorceries, immorality nor theft.
